Manfield and Cleasby Waters

Two miles of the southern (right) bank of the River Tees between the top end of Manfield Scar and Cleasby Deeps.

Above the A1(M) road bridge. Perhaps the least fished part of the Club's water. Difficult access in parts, with lots of over-hanging trees but superb deep holes and fast runs.

Below the A1(M) roadbridge. A variety of water upstream and downstream from Broken Scar Weir.

Excellent stocks of wild brown trout, grayling, dace, chub, barbel and the occasional salmon and sea-trout

Access via Boathouse Lane leading from western end of Cleasby village green to the Low Coniscliffe ford.

Parking area at river end of Boathouse Lane.
